Training Descriptions:

Attendance and Payment Accuracy:

This training helps providers in the Child Care Subsidy program understand the rules and the payment process including tracking and reporting attendance.

CCDF Health and Safety:

This training provides new and renewing registered child care providers with the federally mandated trainings (except First Aid and CPR) that are required by Children's Division to maintain a child care subsidy contract. The topics include: First Aid and CPR Information, including How to Find a Class and Accepted Models (First Aid and CPR are **not** included in this training)—Prevention of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) and Safe Sleeping—Prevention of Shaken Baby Syndrome and Abusive Head Trauma—Emergency Preparedness and Response—Mandatory Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting—Prevention and Control of Infectious Disease, including Immunizations—Administration of Medication, Consistent with Standards for Parental Consent—Prevention and Response to Food Allergy Emergencies—Building and Physical Premises Safety, including Identification of and Protection from Hazards—Handling and Storage of Hazardous Materials and Appropriate Disposal or Bio-Contaminants—Transportation of Children.

CCDF Social and Emotional Health:

This training topic is required for Child Care Subsidy providers and must be completed by June 30, 2018. The main objective of this training is to give you a brief introduction to Early Childhood Social and Emotional Development and to show how important what you do every day is to the growth and development of the children in your care. The topics include: Brain Development—Types of Temperament—Goodness of Fit—Attachment—Social and Emotional Developmental Milestones—Emotional Regulation Skills.

Child Care Online Invoice System:

This training provides training and assistance in registering for and using the DSS Child Care Online Invoice System.

Child Care Subsidy Orientation:

This training provides information about the Child Care Subsidy program that is administered by the Department of Social Services. Child care providers will learn what is required to participate in the Child Care Subsidy program, how to apply for the program, and how to report child attendance.

Pre-Registration Orientation:

This training is an introduction to becoming a Child Care Subsidy provider including health and safety requirements and professional development requirements.
